APPLICANT’S COMMITMENT

One is first a servant then a leader - Leadership Newark’s program takes place one full business day each month from **September 2024 through October 2025**. A retreat is scheduled in late September or early October and usually runs from Thursday through Friday requiring an overnight stay. Participation in the entire opening retreat is **mandatory**. In year two, meetings are scheduled once monthly at the convenience of the group from **November 2025 through June 2026**. Leadership Newark Fellows are expected to attend all seminars and training sessions. Candidates should have the support and commitment of their employers to ensure an understanding of the time commitment required for Leadership Newark participation.

Leadership Newark is generously supported by grants from foundations, corporations and donors. Additionally, upon acceptance to the program, Fellows are required to pay a modest tuition to cover materials. This will be due at the time of acceptance. Notification of acceptance will be in late August. Interested candidates should not let the tuition be a deterrent.
